<p><b>STATIONERY</b></p> <p>The School operates a stationery shop to assist students. This is operated on not-for-profit basis. <p><b>VET COURSES</b></p> <p>The College offers a range of Vocational Education Courses which we manage jointly with an approved Registered Training Organisation (RTO).
