ADDITIONAL NON-TUITION FEES AND COSTS

OVERSEAS STUDENT HEALTH COVER (OSHC)

In order to be granted a student visa, all applicants must provide evidence to the Department of Immigration that the student has OSHC for the duration of their visa

Single cover for 12 months approx. \$500 (for visa duration – please see Bupa for an online calculation of exact cost)

BUILDING FUND

Parents/carers are encouraged to make a donation of \$100 per term to our Approved Building Fund, which is administered by the BTC Foundation. Donations assist the College to fund capital improvements for the wellbeing of all students.

\$400 per annum

EXCURSIONS AND ACTIVITIES – SUPPLEMENTARY CHARGES

Supplementary charges to cover the cost of local, regional, interstate and international excursions, camps, recreational sports, extra-curricular activities, transport to and from events, and other incidental costs incurred by the School will be charged to the fee account. Costs will be advised prior to the event, and a permission slip requesting your consent will be forwarded before the event.

Variable - Year level excursions approx. \$1,000

SCHOOL UNIFORM

School uniform is compulsory. A uniform booklet is available to guide you with required uniforms for each year level.

Full school uniform approx. \$1,000 initial cost

STATIONERY

The School operates a stationery shop to assist students. This is operated on not-for-profit basis. Charges vary from year to year and are available by requesting a stationery list for your child's year level.

Variable, in the range of \$175 - \$350 depending on year level and subjects taken

VET COURSES

The College offers a range of Vocational Education Courses which we manage jointly with an approved Registered Training Organisation (RTO). Costs are charged as incurred, following a letter from the College advising you of the additional costs.

Variable, depending from course to course approx. \$100-\$500

PRIVATE MUSIC LESSONS

The school can assist in arranging private lessons for a range for instruments and singing.

Arranged between private tutor and parents

SPORTS

Additional fees will be payable for children participating in outside sporting activities including Confraternity (if applicable). For all school related sporting activities the fees are covered within the tuition fees.

Variable dependent on individual sport

INCIDENTAL BOARDING COSTS

The following are not provided by the School and students will require their own funds

- Travel to and from airport, medical appointments, weekend leave
- Personal Care items such as toiletries
- Medication prescribed by a medical practitioner
- Mobile Phones
- Pocket Money
